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Dear students, parents/guardians, and First Nations,

The NTC Education, Training & Social Development Department is pleased announce that the NTC K-12 Scholarship Award process is open and the NTC is accepting applications for 2023/24 academic year. The deadline to have applications received by NTC is May 16, 2024 (due no later than 4:30pm). Applications received after this date will be ineligible for 2023/24 NTC Scholarships.

NTC Scholarships are awarded in **Academic, Artistic, Athletic, and Cultural** categories. Students wishing to be considered for scholarships must complete the attached application in full including all supporting documents. Applications and supporting documents can be emailed to **scholarships@nuuchahnulth.org**, or faxed to Richard Samuel's attention at 250.724.9682, or mailed to the NTC main office.

Supporting Documentation and Membership Requirements

Supporting documentation is required for all NTC K-12 Scholarships. Students must submit a short essay and provide a support letter for each scholarship applied for. Students who are applying to more than one NTC Scholarship Award *must* submit a separate essay and documentation for each award and the application form must indicate the NTC Scholarship applied for by checking the appropriate boxes.

Short essay: Essays must be written by the student and explain why they feel that they should receive a scholarship from the scholarship category they are applying for.

Support Letters: Support letters must be provided for Artistic, Athletic, and Cultural Awards by a Mentor, Coach or P.E. Teacher, Elder/Mentor, showing support for the scholarship applicant.

Membership: Only members from one of the following Nuu-chah-nulth Nations are eligible for NTC K-12 Scholarships (Student Status Numbers Must Be Provided on the Application):

Ditidaht Hupacasath Nuchatlaht
Ehattesaht Huu-ay-aht Tla-o-qui-aht
Hesquiaht Kyuquot Tseshaht
Mowachaht/Muchalaht Toquaht

The NTC cannot release awards to anyone other than the student or his or her parent/guardian. Cheques will be available at the Scholarship Awards Ceremony celebration. Any awards not picked up at the Ceremony will be mailed to Scholarship Award recipients at the address provided on the scholarship application.
