Athletic & Hahopchu (Cultural) Scholarship

The NTC Education, Training & Social Development Department is pleased announce that the NTC K-3 Scholarship Award process is open and the NTC is accepting applications for 2022/23 academic year. This year, the NTC Education program is please to expand and offer an **Athletic and Hahopchu (Cultural)** for Nuu-chah-nulth learners in Kindergarten through Grade Three.

The deadline to have applications received by NTC is *May 4, 2023 at 12:00pm.*

Applications received after this date will be ineligible for 2022/23 NTC Scholarships.

Learners wishing to be considered for scholarships must complete the attached application in full including all supporting documents.

For **Athletic**: a short video explaining why they feel that they should receive a scholarship and a support letter, is required.

For **hahopchu (cultural)**: a short video explaining why they feel that they should receive a scholarship and short demonstration of cultural practices (can be included in video or will accept Nuu-chah-nulth art piece) and a support letter, is required.

Students who are applying to more than one NTC Scholarship Award must submit a separate video and documentation for each award and the application form must indicate the NTC Scholarship applied for by checking the appropriate boxes.

Short video: Videos must be minimum 30 seconds and maximum 90 seconds.

Support Letters: Support letters must be provided for Athletic, and Cultural Awards by a Mentor, Coach or P.E. Teacher, Elder/Mentor, showing support for the scholarship applicant.

To be eligible for the scholarship, students must be from one of the following Nuu-chah-nulth Nations:

- Ahousaht
- Ditidaht
- Ehattesaht
- Hesquiaht
- Hupacasath
- Huu-ay-aht
- Kyuquot
- Mowachaht/Muchalaht
- Nuchatlaht
- Tla-o-qui-aht
- Toquaht
- Tseshah

In addition, a learner must have good attendance, participate in school and cultural activities, and be helpful to others.

The NTC cannot release scholarships to anyone other than the student or his or her parent/guardian. The 2023 NTC Scholarship Awards Celebration Event will take place on Friday, June 9th at Alberni District Secondary School (ADSS) with doors opening at 4pm.
