Spousal Students will each receive the *Student with Independent Spouse* Rate. Spousal Students with children: (1) One Student shall receive *SWIS* rate and; (2) the other Student shall receive *SWIS* + *dependents*.

Graduate Incentives: Students enrolled as full-time students in a Level 3 or 4 academic program may receive an incentive once at either level from the recipient, subject to a maximum of \$1,500. This incentive will only be provided once. Students will be eligible for this incentive upon commencement of the second year of the academic program, or upon successful completion of the degree.
