Measles is a highly contagious disease but the vaccine can prevent serious illness. Contact your local immunization provider to check your own or your child's immunization records. You can also check medical records through the BC Health Gateway online: healthgateway.gov.bc.ca

The measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) vaccine is routinely given at 12 months and 4-6 years of age. If you're planning on travelling with young children, talk to your immunization provider about getting a dose before these ages.
